He has worked with many couturiers such as Yves Saint Laurent, Thierry Mugler, Christian Lacroix and Montana...He has created jewelry for Balmain, Givenchy, Nina Ricci, Yves Saint Laurent and Ungaro. His work earned him a mention in the International Dictionary of Jewelry (Editions du Regard – 1998)

Stefano Poletti for Daum



While working with Daum, Stefano admits that he let himself be influenced by... Daum. Captivated by the tradition, amazed by the textures and colours, he conceived Finferlo, an eminently organic vase inspired by the chanterelle mushroom. It is well-known that mushrooms change colour according to the weather. An ideal argument for using Daum's pastel palettes, ranging from shades of orange to soft greens. The "skin" of this chanterelle is engraved, and its tapered edges carefully polished to render the natural fragility of these forest dwellers, which arouse such

enthusiasm among mushroom hunters. Do they belong to the vegetable or animal world? Whichever, they are part of nature. "Daum corresponds with my world on several points", says Stefano. "Furthermore, the story of paste of crystal and jewellery is just beginning, despite its origins dating back a few millennia back".
